

STUDENT ENGAGEMENT AND ATTAINMENT

REGIONAL TARGET: Classroom engagement and participation in a range of courses



SCHOOL TARGET: Increased retention, engagement and successful participation to ensure post-school employment options



FACULTY PLAN: Identification of relevant learning goals that will support participation in a range of appropriate courses in order to maximise post-school options



STRATEGIES



1. Implementation of school-wide PBL strategies to provide consistent expectations of students throughout whole school

2. ITP process to facilitate input from a range of relevant parties to identify and target curriculum options for Stage 6 students

3. Student participation in suitable VET courses as identified in ITPs



4. Students apply learning skills in a range of workplace environments:

- School-based work experience
- Supported Work Crew(enclaves)
- With a job coach
- Independent settings

5. Use of the online form of the Employment Related Log Book to provide evidence of workplace learning and to inform post-school options



- ADHC assessments to determine appropriate pathway for students who require supported post-school options (Transition to Work or Community Participation)
- Students and families teamed with relevant Disability Service Providers in year 12 to establish links prior to exiting school
