Yr10 Food Technology made loaded fries using the sweet potato grown in the farm. It was a huge hit!

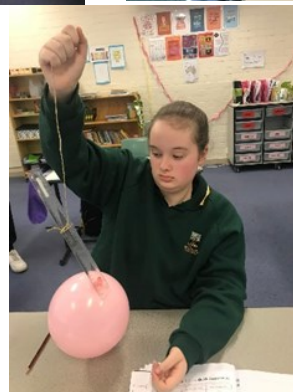
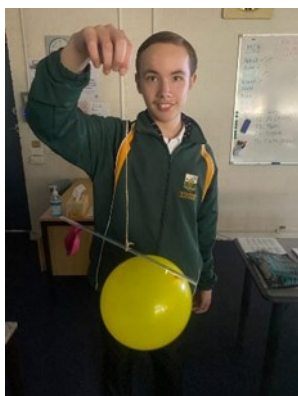




Jemar, Jami and Shania enjoying a bit of afternoon sun sitting at the area dedicated to Mrs Maria Koomen.

MC5 honed their improvisation skills during their Drama lesson today.

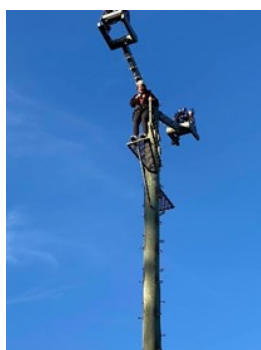

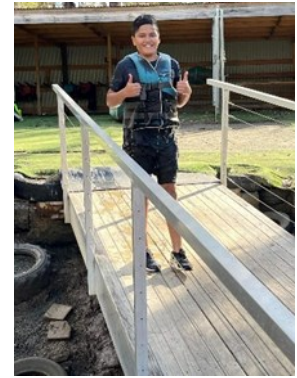

## MESSAGE FROM NSW HEALTH

In Year 11 Mathematics Standard, students have been working on Linear Relationships which involves both algebra and graphing the relationship between 2 variables.

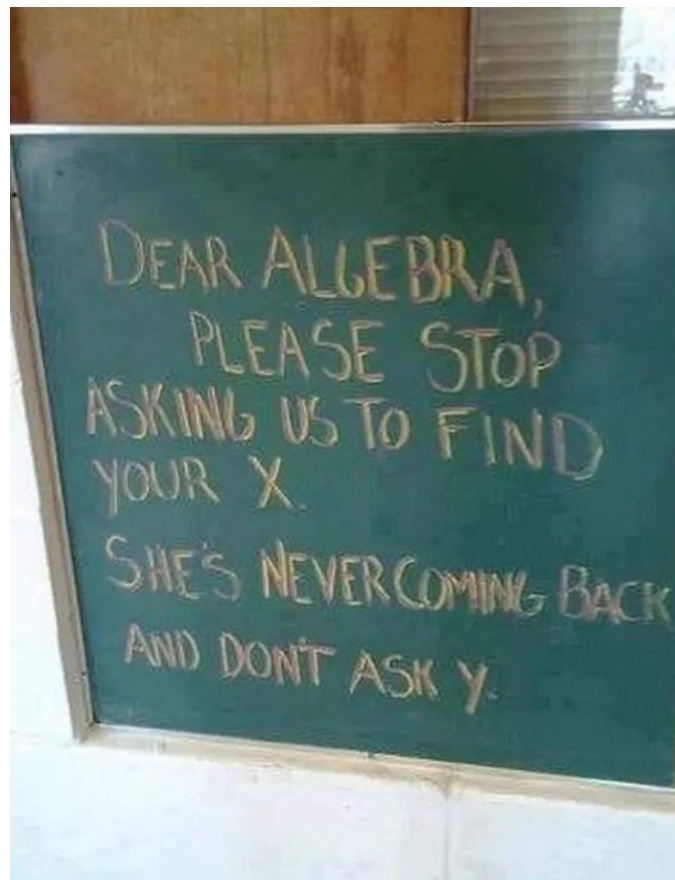
